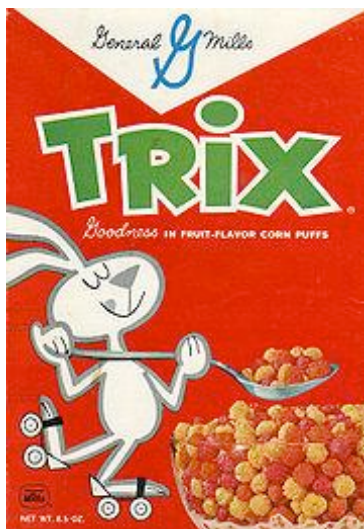
Question 1
